The Central Most shopping centre, with a 38m high clock tower in its south east corner, has become a dominant feature and a prominent landmark of the city of Most.

The entrance areas have been designed to attract attention of shoppers - each of four glazed entrances is different as far as expression is concerned. The overall idea of the project respects the town planning concept of the square including connections of an inner street to geometrical axis of a nearby theatre. The two-storey shopping centre also includes underground parking with 351 parking places. The floors are connected by lifts, escalators and travelators. The shopping gallery comprises of 91 retail units, supermarket and food courts. The main tenants include Albert, Intersport and C&A.

The load-bearing structure is made of precast reinforced concrete frame which is based on large-diameter piles in combination with steel structure. The roof structure consists of a truss frame and trapezoid sheet metal. The outer shell is consists of a combination of sandwich panels, trapezoid sheet metal, plastered brickwork, aluminium cladding and SCHUCO structural glazing.
